San Jose Jazz Summer Fest is a program of San Jose Jazz, a 25 year-old public benefit corporation that enriches our community through jazz education and performance. San Jose Jazz provides music education programs that have helped more than 65,000 gifted and underserved youth in the last decade. The festival is an educational and exciting family adventure. Most stages are outdoors and family friendly. Dance at the salsa stage or have a picnic on the grass at the main stage. Visit The Tech Museum, which is within the festival grounds. During the festival, entrance to The Tech Museum is included in your festival admission and will feature many special activities.

### getting to the festival

The heart of the action, the AT&T Main Stage is located at the Plaza de César Chávez Park in downtown San Jose. The other nine stages and Xfinity Club Crawl venues are located within walking distance from the main stage.

### parking

### public transportation

It is easy to reach the festival using public transportation. The festival is served by VTA Light Rail—it runs every 15 minutes on weekends. Exit at any downtown station. VTA Bus Lines 22, 23, 64, 65, 66, 68, 72, 73, 81, 82, Express 180, and Rapid 522 (\*522 does not operate on Sunday) all run through downtown San Jose. Capitol Corridor, Acerrail and Caltrain serve San Jose Diridon station. VTA Light Rail & Bus 64 connect the station to the festival grounds on weekends.
